The Minneapolis Senior Citizens Advisory Committee to the Mayor and City Council is composed of 23 members that are appointed to two-year terms. One application was received to fill the balance of the current term for Ward 4 with its expiration date of December 31, 2007, and ten reapplications were received for terms to expire on December 31, 2008. There are five vacancies yet to fill - Ward 3, Ward 6, one senior community agency representative, and two member at large positions – that are posted and accepting applications through January 31, 2007. All applications are approved by the Mayor and Council President, with final approval from the full Council.
