Health Energy & Environment Committee Item #7 (Revised)**

**Motion to amend Resolution 2006R-571 entitled “Recognizing Youth Violence as a Public Health Problem and Establishing a Youth Violence Prevention Steering Committee”, passed November 17, 2006, to change the Youth Violence Steering Committee membership from 15 to 27 members, and to include the Chief of Police, Health Commissioner and Executive Director of Youth Coordinating Board as Ex-Officio members.**

That the following Resolved Clause be amended to read as follows:

Be It Further Resolved that the Steering Committee consist of no more than ~~15~~ 25 members, up to ~~seven~~ ten members appointed by the Mayor, and up to ~~eight~~ ten members appointed by the City Council and up to two members to be chosen by the Steering Committee, to include: representatives from the communities most affected by youth violence including at least one representative each from a faith community and the business community and elected officials representing the City ~~and the County~~; ~~appointed officials representing public safety and public health~~. The membership of the panel shall reflect the ethnic and the cultural diversity of Minneapolis and be co-chaired by one community representative and one government representative. The Chief of Police, Health Commissioner and Executive Director of the Youth Coordinating Board will be appointed as nonvoting ex-officio members.
