The City of Minneapolis engaged Bentley Systems Incorporated in August 2001 to assist the City in the implementation of Computer-Aided Civil Engineering Application and Enterprise Concurrent Civil Engineering at a cost of \$3,000,000. The Public Works department continues to use the application.

The contract expires December 31, 2006. Therefore, authorization is requested to increase contract C-17010 with Bentley Systems, Inc. by \$212,610 for 2007 and 2008 maintenance and support.
