Background/Supporting Information

The City of Minneapolis held its annual charitable fund drive from November 4 – November 19, raising funds for eight pre-approved local federations.

I am happy to announce that through the commendable efforts of this year's campaign co-chairs, Bridgette Bornstein (Communications) and Martha Holton Dimick (City Attorney's Office); lead representative for the participating federations, Dan Adolphson; and liaisons from all City departments, the City of Minneapolis was able to raise

\$118,844 in employee contributions which is an increase of \$2,152 over the \$116,692 raised in last year's campaign.
