**Subject Request Permission to Contract with Hennepin County to Provide Investigator Services**

### Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper city officials be authorized to execute the contract agreement for \$67,200 with Hennepin County Attorney's Office for MPD investigator services. The MPD also requests that proper city officials be authorized to execute a contract amendment for approximately \$21,400. The contract and amendment will operate through the revenue fund, 0100-400-C101, Revenue Source 3455.

### Background/Supporting Information

The Police Department will provide an MPD police investigator to provide investigative services to the Hennepin County Attorney's Office. Hennepin County will pay the investigator's salary, fringe benefits, mileage, parking, and other expenses of the investigator to the MPD for such services. There is no financial impact as this revenue was considered in the 2002 Police Department general fund budget. The investigator costs in the initial contract are not sufficient to cover the investigator salary and expenses and a contract amendment is in process in Hennepin County to amend the contract cost.
