**Amending Title 9, Chapter 172 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to  
Civilian Police Review Authority.**

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That section 172.30(c) of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

(c) Minimum training requirements.

1. All members must participate in an annual training session as arranged by the Minneapolis Department of Civil Rights.
2. All new members must complete training in the following subject areas as arranged by the Minneapolis Department of Civil Rights: police use of force, Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, Open Meeting law and Minnesota Public Employee Labor Relations Act, conflict of interest.
3. Within two years of appointment, all new members must complete the portions of the Citizen's Academy as determined by the Minneapolis Department of Civil Rights. Members will be compensated \$50.00 for each Citizen's Academy session attended.
