

**ORDINANCE 2005-Or-\_\_\_\_**

**Amending Title 13, Chapter 341 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances  
relating to Licenses and Business Regulations: Taxicabs.**

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

That Section 341.720 of the above entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

**341.720. Mileage charges.** The maximum rate of fare based upon mileage shall be as follows:

For each load of five (5) passengers, or less, for the first ~~one-eighth (1/8)~~ one-ninth (1/9) mile or fraction thereof . . . \$2.50;

For each succeeding ~~one-eighth (1/8)~~ one-ninth (1/9) of a mile, or fraction thereof . . . \$0.20.

A driver may require a ~~four~~ five dollar (\$4.005.00) minimum charge to employ any taxicab in Minneapolis. If a driver chooses to require a minimum fare, the minimum charge shall be displayed on both sides and the rear of each vehicle. In addition, such notice of minimum charge shall be posted inside in a manner clearly legible to passengers, nor shall any operator be barred from offering a discount to senior citizens whom have attained the age of sixty-five (65) years of age.
