Since 1998 the department has contracted with Hennepin County, as a sub-contractor under their agreement with the Minnesota Department of Human Services, to participate in revenue generation activities as part of the Local Collaborative Time Study (LCTS). The City participates in LCTS through documentation of our provision of federally-reimbursable administrative and/or case management services designed to help families and children access health or health related services. The use of any federal LCTS funds received through the Department of Human Services and Hennepin County are determined through the Family Services Collaborative (FSC) and the Children's Mental Health Collaborative (CMHC). Currently the only LCTS funds received by the City are for the Alliance Home Visiting program.
