

Help sought in finding noncompliant offenders

The Hennepin County Sheriff's Office is looking for help to find six convicted sex offenders who aren't complying with registration requirements. The Sheriff's Office has been searching for the six and hasn't been able to find them, spokeswoman Lisa Kiava said.

State law requires certain offenders to register their address and give authorities other information. The six are:

About the sweep: Since Dec. 21, about 85 people have been arrested by the Sheriff's Office, surrendered and cleared up their warrants.

To determine whether you have an outstanding warrant: Go to the Sheriff's Office warrant unit at Room 22 in the Minneapolis City Hall, 350 S. 5th St. Bring a photo ID. Office hours are 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.

To surrender: Go to the Hennepin County jail, 401 S. 4th Av., Minneapolis, and tell the deputy in the front lobby you are turning yourself in. You will be arrested and booked into the jail. The length will depend on bail amount, release conditions and court schedule. Bring a government ID, any necessary prescription medications and cash if you plan to post bail.
