**Supporting Information**

The MPD was invited in April 2009 to participate on the Minnesota Internet Crimes Against Children (ICAC) Task Force and to receive federal funding through the Minnesota Bureau of Criminal Apprehension to fund overtime expenses. The overtime funds are available for the two Forensic Computer Analysts or Investigators participating on the ICAC Task Force. The grant reimburses travel and subsistence expenses receiving prior approval. This amendment increases the program funding by \$5,000 to a total of \$20,000.
