**AN ORDINANCE

Amending Title 17, Chapter 435 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Streets and Sidewalks: Parcel and Structure Numbering.

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 435.60 of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

435.60. Address display. ~~The owner of any public or non public residential, commercial, industrial, or other building in the city shall display properly on the front and rear thereof and in a position easily observed from the street, and in numbers not less than four (4) inches in height, the proper address number of such building.~~ New and existing buildings shall have approved address numbers, building numbers or approved building identification placed in a position that is plainly legible and visible (1) from the street or road fronting the property and (2) from the rear or on a building accessory to the building at the rear. The rear address number may be omitted if there is no public way at the rear of the building. The numbers shall contrast with their background. Address numbers shall be Arabic numerals. Numbers shall be a minimum of four (4) inches high with a minimum stroke width of one-half (1/2) inch. The numbers shall not be comprised of spray painted or hand-painted numbers nor shall the numbers be otherwise hand-applied by marker, tape or similar product not pre-fabricated for the specific purpose of address identification.

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**Amending Title 12, Chapter 244 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances
relating to Housing Maintenance Code: Fire Protection.**

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 244.970 of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

244.970. Address posting. Every dwelling shall have the proper street address number conspicuously posted in the front and in the rear or on a building accessory to such dwelling at the rear so as to be readily identified in case of fire or other emergency. ~~The rear address number may be omitted if there is no public way at the rear of the building. The numbers required by this section shall be mounted on a permanently fixed surface, the numbers shall be Arabic, not Roman numerals or words, and shall be of sufficient size (two (2) inches minimum height) and of a contrasting color so as to be readily distinguishable and readable from the public way front and rear~~ accordance with section 435.60.

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**Amending Title 11, Chapter 225 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances
relating to Garbage and Refuse: City Collection and Disposal.**

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 225.620 of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

225.620. Buildings to be numbered. (a) Owners, operators, or occupants of buildings containing dwelling units receiving solid waste collection from the city shall affix the street address number of such building in a manner and place in accordance with sections 244.970, ~~and 435.20~~ and 435.60 that is easily and readily discernible by collection crews.

(b) The city engineer shall provide written notice to the taxpayer and to the utility bill payer of unnumbered buildings that unless numbered as described in paragraph (a) above within fourteen (14) days, the city engineer shall place numbers on the building.

(c) The city engineer shall establish a schedule of charges for services provided in paragraph (b) above based on the cost of materials and providing such service. Service charges shall be added to the utility bill as provided in section 509.870.
