Subject PERMISSION TO AMEND THE STATE JUVENILE JUSTICE ADVISORY COMMITTEE GRANT

Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to execute the Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee Grant award second amendment for \$2,000 from the Minnesota Department of Economic Security and to execute the required contract agreements with Walker Community United Methodist Church for the funded program. The grant award will operate in 2002 in Grant Special Revenue Fund 0300-400-C011, Revenue Source 3210, with federal funds passed through the state agency.

Background/Supporting Information

The Police Department requests permission to proceed with the Minnesota Juvenile Justice Advisory Committee Grant award 2nd amendment from the Minnesota Department of Economic Security for \$2,000 for a program training and technical assistance funding. The grant award funds the Walker Community Methodist Church Family Group Conferencing Program, a community-based restorative justice program for qualifying first time juvenile offenders. There is no required local match on this additional award for training and technical assistance. Five percent of the total award will be retained by the MPD for grant administration.
