The Quarterly Contract Compliance Report for the 3<sup>rd</sup> Quarter 2010 details the Contract Compliance activities and reports the Departments' monitoring and enforcement of minority and woman participation on City of Minneapolis projects in accordance with 139.5 and Chapter 423 of the city ordinances.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter report highlights:

- There are currently 44 active construction projects totaling \$129,458,866.
- 18.2% Minority (combined participation) this includes skilled and unskilled labor hours.
- 4.88% Female labor hours, this is the 2<sup>nd</sup> consecutive quarter where the percentage increased.
- Total Minority Business Participation equaled \$10,238,827, or 9.36%
- Total Woman Business Participation equaled \$11,482,725, or 10.39%
