### Supporting Information

The Quarterly Contract Compliance Report for the 1st Quarter 2011 details the Contract Compliance activities and reports the Departments' monitoring and enforcement of minority and woman participation on City of Minneapolis projects in accordance with 139.5 and Chapter 423 of the city ordinances.

The 1st quarter report highlights:

- 61 active construction projects totaling \$185,405,222.
- 17.3% Minority (combined participation). This includes skilled and unskilled labor hours.
- 5.36 Female labor hours.
- Total Minority Business Participation equaled \$15,948,154, or 9.92%
- Total Woman Business Participation equaled \$18,808,413, or 11.7%
