**Subject Request Approval to Amend the Contract Agreement For
Financial Crimes Task Force**

Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests that the proper officials be authorized to amend a contract agreement with the Minnesota Financial Crimes Task Force to receive \$34,350 for Minneapolis Police participation in the Minnesota Financial Crimes Task Force. The Police Department requests an amendment to increase the general appropriation resolution for 2005 by the amount of \$34,350. The contract will operate through the federal grant fund, 0300-400-C117, Revenue Source 3210.
