## **Supporting Information**

The proposed amendment reconciles Chapter 28 with Article XII of Chapter 20, governing the creation of unclassified service positions in the City. The reorganization of the Department of Regulatory Services includes the creation of appointed Deputy Director positions. The amendment eliminates any potential conflict or ambiguity in Chapter 28 concerning the appointed status of the Deputy Directors. The amendment also expands the skill sets required of the Director of Inspections, to better reflect those needed in that position.
