#### **Background/Supporting Information**

The Minneapolis Police Department (MPD) and State of Minnesota support each other with cooperative law enforcement activities. The State of Minnesota offers training (at no cost) to the City of Minneapolis by allowing officers to gain on-the-job experience with the Department of Corrections. The MPD and the city benefit by developing information sharing and gaining experience in probationary and detention protocols.

There is no cost to the city. This consent confirms past and current practice of allowing the Minneapolis Police Department to continue to interface with state agencies.

\* There is currently no officer detailed to the Department of Corrections. The MPD anticipates that with staffing increase in 2007, this opportunity be able to be filled (normally for 90 days).
