


The Minneapolis Interchange

What is The Interchange “Phase 1”

vs

“Phase 2”?



Phase 1 is focused on LRT:

- Provide an additional LRT Platform and additional public queuing and pedestrian circulation space
- Support future connections to Southwest and Bottineau LRT alignments
- Provide Metro Transit with an LRT Storage Track to support downtown civic events and daily operations

Phase 2 is:

- Completion of a 21st Century transit hub that accommodates multimodal transit connections and supports economic development
- Additional platform and track space including a layover site for future commuter and intercity rail operations down in “the cut”

The Interchange Phase 1 Timeline



- Responses to RFQ for Environmental Assessment due Friday
- July 2010 – Form Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and begin meeting regularly
- Summer – Fall 2010 – Form The Interchange Working Group
- Summer 2011 – Complete the EA
- Winter 2011 – Final design of Phase 1 complete
- 2012 – 3rd Quarter 2014 – Construction...to be complete prior to CCLRT beginning service
