Background/Supporting Information: The 2009 calendar for the 2010 budget process follows for the review of the Committee. The committee receives a preliminary version of the calendar in April, with the dates and times of truth in taxation hearings marked tentative pending legislative action on truth in taxation.

The City will certify these dates to the County on September 15, 2009, as required by Minnesota Statute. This information will be included on Truth in Taxation notices in November.

Budget adoption must follow a continuation hearing, if needed. The continuation hearing must be at least 5 business days from the initial truth in taxation hearing.
