Hennepin County Medical Center – Emergency Medical Services (HCMC – EMS) is submitting a reimbursement request for training and services performed during the Republican National Convention along with the reimbursement request from the Minneapolis Police Department. While the Police Department has council approval through a mutual aid agreement to obtain reimbursement for training and enforcement services, we are now requesting approval to enter into an agreement to reimburse HCMC for their services performed during the convention as approved by St. Paul and in agreement with our Mutual Aid Agreement.

An additional invoice was submitted for reimbursement subsequent to the submission of the initial letter to council. The Police Department expects reimbursement up to \$95,000 from St. Paul.
