Subject: FEMA Fire Act Grant for the purchase of new defibrillator units.

Presenters in Committee: Rocco Forte', Fire Chief, Kristin Rollwagen, Fire Department and Sarah Moffitt, Empowerment Zone and Grants Office.

Recommendation:

Request authorization to (1) Accept the \$105,000 grant from FEMA for the purchase of new defibrillator units. Fire Department will provide the required City share cost of the project from its general operating budget, in the amount of \$45,000. (2) Increase the appropriation for the Fire Department Agency in the Grants – Federal Fund (Fund 0300 Agency 280 Organization 2820 Object 8020) by \$105,000 and increase the Revenue Source (Fund 0300 Agency 280 Organization 2820 Revenue Source 3210) by \$105,000, and (3) Execute any other sub-recipient agreements necessary to implement the project.

Background/Supporting Information - The Minneapolis Fire Department was awarded a FEMA Fire Act grant for the purchase of 40 new defibrillator units. As required by the grant guidelines, the City's Fire Department will cover 30% (or \$45,000) of the defibrillator cost. The cost of the city's share has been identified in the Fire Department's budget.
