Recommendation

The Minneapolis Police Department respectfully requests approval to accept up to \$55,120 from the Plymouth Christian Youth Center for crime prevention services and for the proper city officials to execute the contract agreement. The Police Department requests an amendment to increase the general appropriation resolution for 2005 by the amount of \$55,120. The grant award will operate through the Grants - Other fund 0600-400-P400, Revenue Source 3720.

The assigned Crime Prevention Specialist will work within the PCYC Alternative Schools and with neighborhood youth to focus on reducing crime and improving livability in the Jordan, Near North/Willard Hay, and Hawthorne neighborhoods. The Police Department will pay the fringe benefits for the Crime Prevention Specialist position.
