## **Supporting Information**

**Public comment for the 2009 Consolidated Plan is set for March 13 through April 14, 2009. Until Congress finalizes the federal budget, the funding budget presented is an estimate pending final Federal appropriation. The 2009 Consolidated Plan is the City's application to U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for 2009 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Home Investment Partnerships (HOME), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA) funding, and American Dream Downpayment Assistance Initiative (ADDI) and it is an update to the 2005-09 Five-Year Strategy.**
