


Now collecting bags of leaves until the week of November 15

For the 2004 season, **6 a.m. on your garbage day** in

the week of November 15 is the final day to have leaves, brush and other yard trimmings collected. Make sure to have your bags of leaves and bundles of brush at your alley line or curb line, next to the garbage cart.



Bags of leaves **must**

weigh less than 40

pounds. Do not use bags

larger than 33 gallons.

Each **bundle of brush**

must be **less than 3**

feet long and weigh

less than 40 pounds.

Remember, it is a violation of **City ordinance** to place yard or boulevard leaves in the street. Doing so can plug up the storm drains and contribute to the growth of too much algae in our lakes, which harms fish and other plants and gives off a bad smell.

Fall street sweeping is approaching



Public Works will begin the **annual fall street sweep** in

mid-October and finish in

mid-November. Cars must

be moved so that crews can clear fallen leaves

from the streets. **Streets will be posted**

with signs at least 24 hours before towing

begins. Signs will specify the day of the week

that parking is banned and read "No Parking

7:00 AM to 4:30 PM."



Save yourself the inconvenience and expense of having your car towed. Please do not leave your car unattended on the street for more than 24 hours at a time. Watch for signs each day when you park your car on the street, or make arrangements with a friend or neighbor if you are not able to check every day.

Remember, it is a violation of City ordinance to place yard or boulevard leaves in the street.
