Background/Supporting Information:

The Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) is planning to replace the deck on the Riverside Avenue Bridge over I-94 in the spring of 2004. As part of this replacement, MnDOT has agreed to replace the existing bridge street lighting system. The street lighting design includes the removal of the existing system and the installation of six twin acorn fixtures. This would be similar to the completed MnDOT Bridge Projects on: 27th Avenue South over I-94, and E. 26th Street, 28th Street, 50th Street and Diamond Lake Road over I-35W. The work will include conduits, cables, poles, fixtures and all labor associated with the installation. The City's share of the cost is \$15,550, which is programmed in the Public Works 2004 Street Light Capital

Fund for Street Light Renovation (TR011). Public Works requests that the proper City Officials be directed to execute Agreement No. 85785-R with The Minnesota Department of Transportation in the amount of \$15,550 for the installation of street lights on the Riverside Bridge.
