The Mayor appoints members of The Minneapolis Private Industry /Workforce Council, which oversees the operation of the City's employment and training programs. Federal requirements require that specific sectors be represented on the council. Bill McCarthy, President of the Minneapolis Central Labor Union would fill one of the two labor seats. Obie Kipper, Regional Area Manager for MN Rehabilitative Services in North Minneapolis would fill the vocational rehabilitation agency seat. Dr. Trinch a chiropractor in South Minneapolis would fill a small business seat on the council.
