Amending Title 10, Chapter 186 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to the Food Code: In General.

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 186.50 of the above-entitled ordinance be amended by adding thereto the following definitions in alphabetical sequence to read as follows:

186.50. Definitions. All terms used in this title, unless expressly defined in this section, shall be interpreted as defined in the Minnesota Food Code, part 4626.0020, as they may be amended from time to time. The following terms shall have the following meanings:

Bakery shall mean a food establishment that prepares baked bread products and pastries. For the purpose of licensing, a bakery shall be licensed as a restaurant.

Caterer shall mean a food establishment that delivers and serves prepared food or a food establishment that delivers the food in multi-use utensils that will be returned for re-use.

Food confectionery shall mean a food establishment that sells candy, snacks, pop, fruit drinks, and single-serve ice cream products. A confectionery may sell milk in individual portions of ten (10) ounces or less.

Food distributor shall mean a food establishment that prepares and distributes food to other food establishments to sell.

Food institutional establishment shall mean a Risk one (1), Risk two (2), or Risk three (3) food establishment engaged in the care of people by preparing and serving food on a regular basis. This shall include, but is not limited to, non-profit organizations, adult daycare, child daycare, after-school programs, schools, meals for the elderly, emergency meals, and congregate dining.

Food market distributor means a vendor in a public or municipal market that is selling or reselling foods for off-site consumption.

Food market manufacturer means a vendor in a public or municipal market, with the exception of the Nicollet Mall extension, that is selling foods for immediate consumption.

Food meat market shall mean a food establishment that manufactures, processes, prepares, stores, handles, or sells raw animal products. For the

purpose of licensing, a store that handles raw fish shall be licensed as a meat market.

Food restaurant shall mean a Risk one (1), Risk two (2), or Risk three (3) food establishment that prepares food for take out or dine-in service.
