## **Background Information**

The previous ordinance, sent to the Ways and Means Committee on November 5, 2001, stated an incorrect effective date for the increase for the ironworkers. The original information provided by the Ironworkers Local Union No. 512, listed an effective date of July 1, 2001. The correct effective date is June 4, 2001.

The difference in effective dates resulted in incorrect backpay for permit ironworkers. In order to rectify this oversight, it is necessary to submit a revised ordinance for your approval. The attached ordinance corrects this error.
