Minnesota Statute requires local service units (LSU's) to complete an annual plan update. The update addresses annual performance review of the LSU's employment and training service providers; the county option to adopt a sanction with greater consequence; the exit interview process and determination of hardship extensions; and Employment Service and Local Intervention Grants for Self-Sufficiency updates and budgets. This is an update to the two-year Local Service Unit Plan covering the delivery of MFIP Employment services for the period 7/1/01 through 6/30/03. Staff from the City and County have worked cooperatively in the preparation of the amendment. The plan amendment needs the signature of the mayor.
