**Amending Title 13, Chapter 303 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances
relating to Horse and Carriage Livery Services.**

The City Council of The City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 303.30 of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

303.30. License fee; cleanup fee. The annual license fee and street cleanup fee for a horse and carriage livery service shall be as established in Appendix J, License Fee Schedule. The cleanup fee shall be collected by the department of licenses and consumer services with the annual license fee and shall be credited to the department of public works for street maintenance purposes. The cleanup fee shall not apply to licensees who operate for ten (10) or fewer days in a calendar year.

Section 2. That Section 303.110 of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

303.110. Temporary routes. The director of public works may establish a temporary horse and carriage route for a period not to exceed ten (10) calendar days. The use of temporary routes shall be restricted to either licensees in good standing or any person obtaining a Class A or B hooped animal permit pursuant to section 74.60 who operates a horse and carriage livery service at events not open to the general public such as, but not limited to, weddings. The director of public works may, if necessary, assign a maximum number of horse and carriage vehicles to any temporary route, and may allocate the use of a temporary route equitably among licensees if necessary. Any licensee wishing to use a temporary route shall obtain a permit for such use from the director of public works and pay a permit as established in Appendix J, License Fee Schedule.
