Dear Rebecca:

As you know, the Minneapolis Park and Recreation Board and City of Minneapolis have been in the planning stages for redeveloping both the west and east banks of the Mississippi River, particularly the area upstream of Plymouth Avenue. Our joint planning efforts have provided for the master plan, titled - Above the Falls, which was adopted by the Park Board and the City in 2001. Since then, the Park Board has taken further planning steps to develop the schematic design along the west side of the river, known as Above the Falls – Phase I.

To date, much of the redevelopment efforts along the river have occurred south of Plymouth Avenue, however; today we are ready to begin improvements to the north. This area includes the riverbank and West River Road between Plymouth Avenue and the railroad tracks just north of 22nd Avenue N. The redevelopments efforts will include a 'parkway-like' experience, similar to the area south of Plymouth Avenue, and allow for a variety of recreation facilities.

Currently, this section of West River Road has been included in the 'Service Redesign' program, whereby the City maintains the roadway surface and the Park Board maintains the turf and landscaped area, including the riverbank. Past discussions between the City and Park Board over the ownership of the roadway Right-of-Way and riverbank have taken place. We are now at a point in time where the Park Board can take ownership and begin redevelopment efforts of the Phase I area.

By way of this letter, and for consideration of \$1, I am asking that the City transfer ownership to the Park Board. Attached is a map showing the identified parcels. This transfer not only allows us to redevelop this stretch of river, but enables the availability for regional funding sources to be used. The City will likely realize much more in future tax revenue due to increased property values associated with being adjacent to parks, as has happened in the past.




