Curfew Hours

It is important for both parents and children to know the curfew rules. Hennepin County Ordinance No. 16, Sub. A, B, or C, establishes the times youth are to be at home on weekdays and weekends. Curfews are set for youth ages 17 and under. The first ticket is \$25.00, the second is \$50.00, and a third ticket could result in a

court date. Youth with a prior record are required to go to court when the first ticket is issued. For more information visit

Absentee Balloting has Begun for Aug. 10 Primary



The 2010 Election season brings two schedule changes for voters that include a new earlier primary date, and a longer 46-day absentee balloting period for both the primary and for the general election. Voters unable to vote in person at the polls on Election Day may vote in person or by mail. Absentee ballot applications are available on our website and may be sent anytime throughout the year. Absentee voting for the primary opens Friday, June 25 at the Minneapolis Office of Elections, 350 Fifth St. S. – Room 1B (ground floor of City Hall).
