**Amending Title 14, Chapter 360 of the Minneapolis Code of Ordinances relating to Liquor and Beer: In General.**

The City Council of the City of Minneapolis do ordain as follows:

Section 1. That Section 360.120 of the above-entitled ordinance be amended to read as follows:

**360.120. Proximity to schools and religious institution places of assembly.**

No on-sale liquor, wine or beer license, except in the B4 zoning district, shall be issued for any building, room or place within three hundred (300) feet from any building space that is used primarily and regularly for any public or parochial schools ~~or used primarily and regularly for any religious institution place of assembly~~, said distance to be measured in a straight line from the principal public entrance of the school ~~or religious institution place of assembly~~ space to the main public entrance of the premises for which license is sought. No off-sale liquor license, except in the B4 zoning district, shall be issued for any building, room or place within three hundred (300) feet from any building space that is used primarily and regularly for any public or parochial schools or used primarily and regularly for any religious institution place of assembly, said distance to be measured in the shortest straight line from the property line of the premises or building proposed as the location for the license sought to the property line of the school or religious institution place of assembly. An establishment licensed for the off-sale of malt liquor pursuant to Section 362.45 may be located within three hundred (300) feet from a building space that is used primarily and regularly for any religious institution place of assembly.
