## **CRA Highlights**

**(January – March 2011)**

### **Overview of CRA Complaints**

- Received 75 initial complaints
- Closed 73 percent of the initial complaints received during the first quarter
- Received 22 signed complaints
- Excessive Force allegations accounted for 45% percent of allegations received
- Closed 15 priority complaint investigations, averaging 98 days
- First Precinct received the most complaints
- Ward 7 received the most complaints
- Blacks filed the most complaints

### **Chief's Discipline**

The Chief did not impose discipline on any officers during the first quarter.
