Background/Supporting Information Attached

The City has received additional funding for participating in Public Health Preparedness and Response to Bioterrorism as part of the metro region public health emergency preparedness planning. This amendment provides additional funds for planning and implementation of pandemic influenza activities. This includes completing a CDC Local Public Health Assessment with a list of gaps and priorities, beginning modifications to the local All-Hazards Plan to address priority issues, and draft and exercise plan within the next year. In addition, provide technical assistance to local businesses, schools, community groups, health care providers, and the general public, as time and funding allow.
