

## VOCATIONAL TRAINING INQUIRY

If you are interested in funding to go to school, it may be available to qualified clients. Funding for tuition, books, supplies and a monthly discount voucher bus card is available to a limited number of City of Minneapolis residents who meet the WIA income guidelines. The NET agency does not pay for your training. NET does the assessment, testing and paperwork and refers your file to the City of Minneapolis Employment and Training Program (METP). There are slots for a limited number of individuals wanting to go to a technical school for up to two years. You will be required to take achievement and aptitude testing as part of assessment for training. Your file and request for training assistance will be reviewed by METP. METP has the right to accept or reject any plans submitted by the NET counselor.

Funding for vocational training is also available to clients (not necessarily City of Minneapolis residents) under the EDWAA Dislocated Worker's Training if you have been laid off work.

A counselor will explain more about the training plans during assessment.
