RE: Update on 2011 CLG Historic Resources Survey Project

---

In January 2011 CPED and the consultant for the project, Mead & Hunt Inc., embarked on the final year of the historic resources re-survey project. In 2000, the City of Minneapolis set a goal and set aside funds to re-survey the entire city within a ten year period. Since 2001, the City of Minneapolis has been leveraging CLG grant funds with matching funds to re-survey the entire city. This year's survey includes three geographic areas (see attached [map](#)):

- The “Camden” Survey Area contains portions of Victory, Shingle Creek, Webber-Camden, Humboldt Industrial Area, Lind-Bohanon, and portions of Folwell, McKinley, and Cleveland neighborhoods
- The “Central Core” Survey Area contains portions of St. Anthony West, Marcy Holmes, Como, Downtown West, Downtown East, Sumner Glenwood, and portions of Bryn Mawr, Harrison, Near North, North Loop, and Prospect Park neighborhoods
- The “WKA” Survey Area contains Windom, Kenny, and Armatage neighborhoods

The purpose of the survey is to:

- Identify unknown historic properties;
- Recommend properties for further study;
- Make informed decisions about the significance and protection of historic resources;
- Develop goals and strategies for preservation as well as neighborhood planning.

At the March 22, 2011 HPC meeting staff will discuss the progress of the 2011 re-survey project and potential next steps to follow-up on the entire re-survey effort.
