Loring Park, Harmon Place and Maple Street  
Jacob Fjelde, 1897

Minneapolis' first public sculpture was commissioned in 1895 by the Norwegian-American community. Ole Bull (1810-1880) was a world famous Norwegian violinist who toured the Midwest. An excerpt from the "The Goat Girl's Sunday" appears on the front.
