Planning for Lyn-Lake Area Nears Completion

WHAT: The City of Minneapolis has worked with Lyn-Lake area neighborhoods and businesses to develop a small area plan and seeks feedback on the recommendations for the plan drive future development in the Lyn-Lake area.

The Lyn-Lake Small Area Plan process began in April, 2008. Since that time, three community meetings have been held to get input for shaping the future of this area.

Following the meeting, the draft will be made available for a 45-day public comment period before it is presented to the City Planning Commission and the City Council for adoption.

WHEN: February 19, 2009, 7-8:30 p.m.

WHERE: Bryant Square Park, 3101 Bryant Avenue South

MORE: A small area plan is a document that is developed for a clearly defined geographic area that outlines a long-range vision for land use and development. A small area plan shares the goals, policies and implementation steps in the City's comprehensive plan while providing a finer level of detail.

The plan examines the current conditions of the area, develops a future vision of what residents, business owners, and other stakeholders want an area to become and then formulates specific goals, objectives, and policies that will help implement that vision. The Lyn-Lake Small Area Plan will be based on input received through a series of public meetings.
