SUBJECT: CPC / CLIC Joint Public Meeting

The Capital Long-Range Improvement Committee (CLIC) is a 33 member citizen advisory committee to the Mayor and City Council. Its role is to rate and prioritize proposed capital projects (termed Capital Budget Requests or CBRs), submit comments on the proposals, and ultimately submit a recommendation on a cohesive five-year Capital Improvement Program to the Mayor and City Council. After modifications by the Mayor and City Council, the Capital Improvement Program is formally adopted as part of the City's budget for the upcoming year.

At the present time, all CBRs have been presented to CLIC by City staff. Initial rating conversations have occurred, and comments on the proposed projects have been drafted. The attached materials list the CBRs with their requested financing. The May 9 Joint Public Meeting represents the annual opportunity for the CLIC Committee to receive input from the public on the proposed capital projects. Public notice was sent to all neighborhood organizations and published in Finance and Commerce. By City Charter, the public hearing is co-hosted by the City Planning Commission, who may also comment on the projects.
