Notice of Decision for the Environmental Assessment Worksheet for L&H Station

March 9, 2015 (Minneapolis) - The City of Minneapolis has completed the Environmental Assessment Worksheet (EAW) process for the L&H Station project located on the property at 2225 East Lake Street in Minneapolis. On February 27, 2015, the City Council decided to not order the development of an Environmental Impact Statement (EIS), therefore making a Negative Declaration, and adopting the Findings of Fact and Record of Decision document. This City Council action was approved by the Mayor on March 6, 2015, and was published in the Finance and Commerce newspaper on March 7, 2015.
