

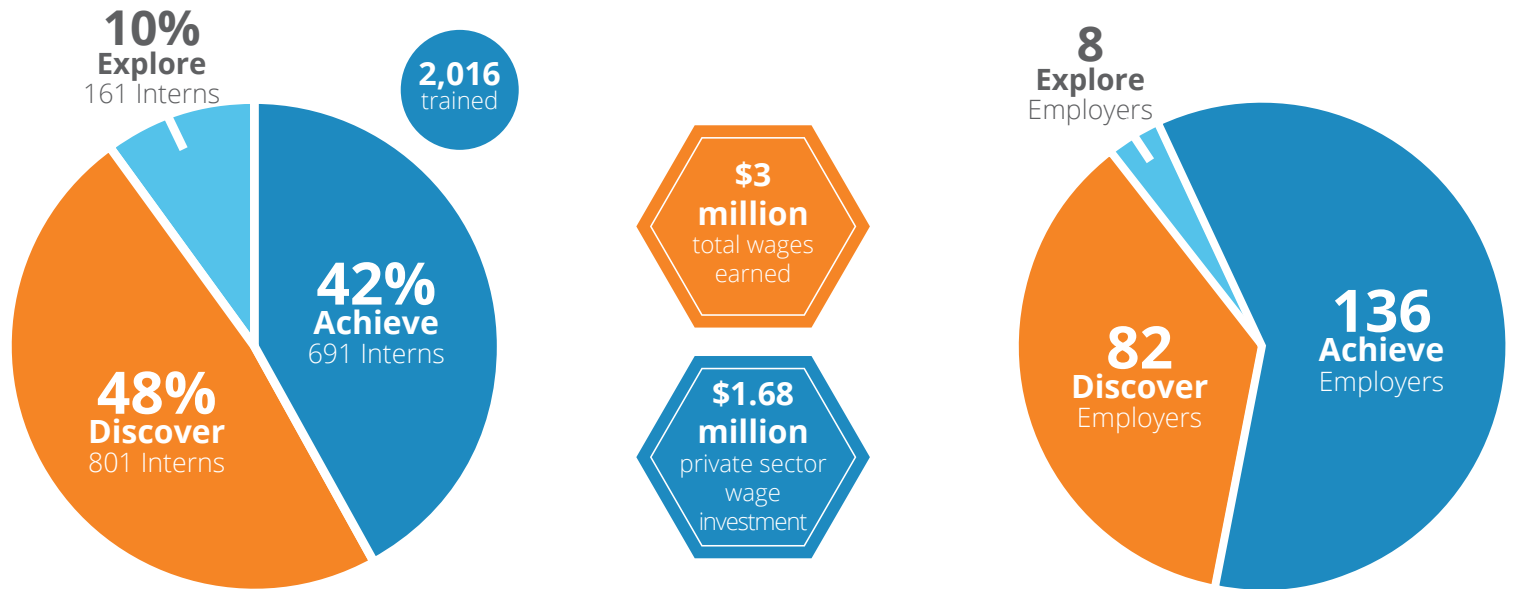

AT A GLANCE

STEP-UP IS THE CITY OF MINNEAPOLIS YOUTH EMPLOYMENT PROGRAM FOR YOUNG ADULTS AGES 14-21.

Each year STEP-UP recruits, trains and places more than 1,600 Minneapolis youth in paid internships with over 220 top Twin Cities businesses, public agencies and nonprofits.

STEP-UP INTERNS EXPLORE DIVERSE CAREER INTERESTS, GAIN ON THE JOB SKILLS AND PREPARE FOR MEANINGFUL CAREERS.



For youth 14 or 15 years old, STEP-UP Discover offers entry-level internships in nonprofit and community organizations for youth with limited work experience to develop skills in preparation for more challenging opportunities. Directed by the City of Minneapolis.



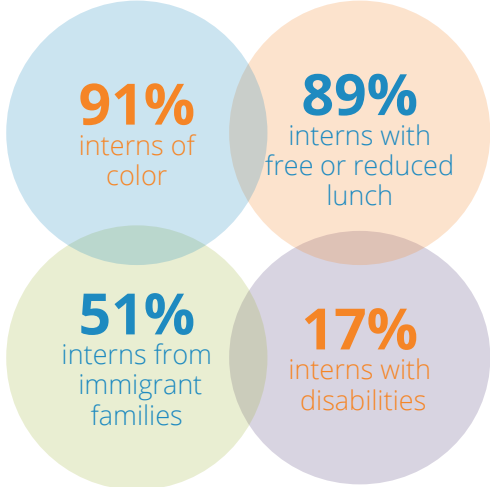
For youth 16 - 21 years old, STEP-UP Achieve offers career-oriented internships for interns who are seeking a professional experience and more challenging opportunities. Youth work in private sector businesses, public agencies and nonprofits. Directed by AchieveMpls.

STEP-UP Explore offered concentrated work and training opportunities in a specific trade or industry and supported training and work experiences for youth with disabilities. Most organizations and interns who worked through Explore in 2017 will work through Discover or Achieve in 2018. Directed by the City of Minneapolis.

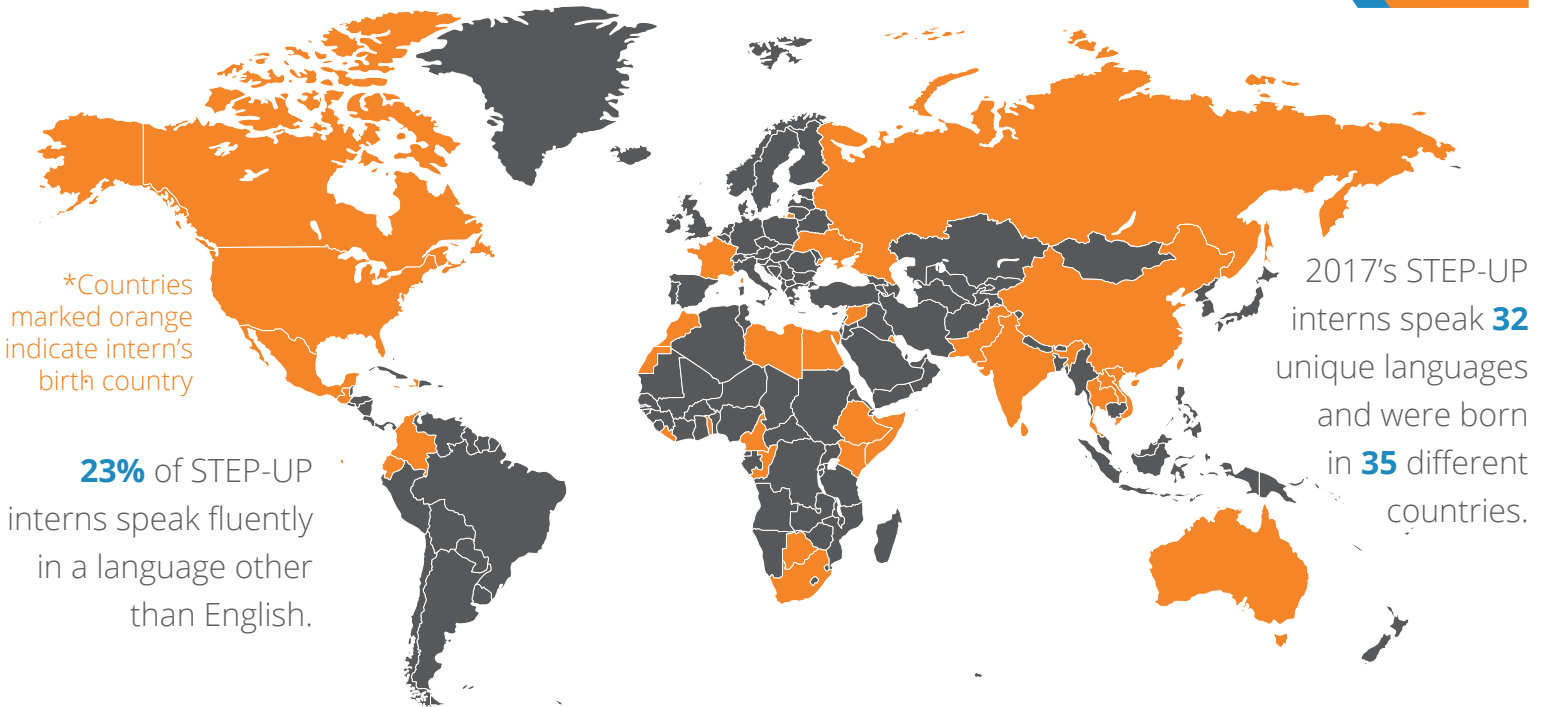
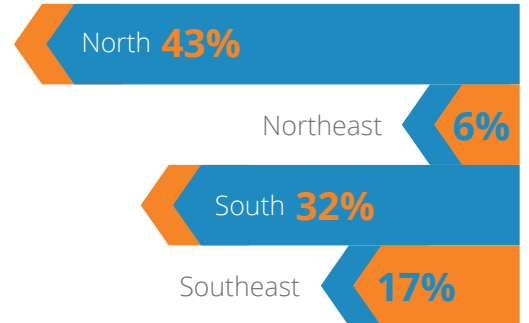
