

### Average Hiring Competition Over a Thin Supply of Regional Talent




#### Supply (Jobs)

Minneapolis-St. Paul-Bloomington, MN-WI is not a hotspot for this kind of talent. The national average for an area this size is 28,065\* employees, while there are 23,403 here.



#### Compensation

#### **Demand (Job Postings)**



# Supply (Jobs)

### Supply Is Lower Than the National Average

The regional vs. national average employment helps you understand if the supply of Patient Care Assistants is a strength or weakness for Minneapolis-St. Paul-Bloomington, MN-WI, and how it is changing relative to the nation. An average area of this size would have 28,065\* employees, while there are 23,402 here. This lower than expected supply may make it more difficult to find candidates. 
# Most Talent is Found in the Nursing Care Facilities (Skilled Nursing Facilities) Sector



### Retirement Risk Is Low, While Overall Diversity Is Low




#### **Retiring Soon**

Retirement risk is low in Minneapolis-St. Paul-Bloomington, MN-WI. The national average for an area this size is 1,064\* employees 65 or older, while there are 720 here.

#### **Gender Diversity**



# Talent Is 22% More Expensive, While the Cost of Living Should Make Attraction Easier

In 2016, the median compensation for Patient Care Assistants in Minneapolis-St. Paul-Bloomington, MN-WI is \$34,101. Based on the national median wage of \$28,025 for this position, this means you will spend about 22% more to employ Patient Care Assistants here. However, their actual purchasing power will be 17% greater than the national median when we adjust for regional cost of living (which is 4% higher than average). This may make it easier to attract talent to the region at this price.



# Demand (Job Postings)

### For Every 1,131 Unique Job Postings, Only 1,130 Positions Are Filled

If there is a gap between unique job postings and positions filled, it may indicate unmet demand for Patient Care Assistants. In the average month over the last 12 months, there were 1,131 unique job postings for Patient Care Assistants, while 1,130 positions were filled. Since unique job postings and positions filled were roughly equal, there doesn't seem to be any unmet demand here.

### **608 Companies Are Competing for Talent**
