

TENNESSEN WARNING AND DATA PRIVACY ACT NOTICE

TENNESSEN WARNING

As an applicant for the Minneapolis Homes Program, you will be asked to provide information that may be considered private under the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act (the "Act"). The Act requires you be provided with the following information.

The data that you will be asked to provide to the City of Minneapolis for the Minneapolis Homes Program (the "Program") includes, but is not limited to the following data about members of your household:

- Income and financial statements
Credit Reports
Social security numbers
Identity and demographic information of household members

The foregoing information is needed to determine if you qualify for participation in the program. You may refuse to provide the requested information, but this may result in delay in processing or rejection of your application.

This information may be shared with the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), City of Minneapolis staff, Minnesota Housing Finance Agency and contractors whose jobs require them to see it. Where access to the data is authorized by state statute or federal law, it may be made available to others as so authorized.

PRIVACY ACT NOTICE

As an applicant for Minneapolis Homes, you will be asked to provide your social security number. The federal Privacy Act of 1974 requires that you be provided with the following information:

- Furnishing your social security number is mandatory for the Program to determine your eligibility for financing.
The statutory authority for the Program to request disclosure of your social security number is 24 CFR 5.216.
