HAZARDOUS MATERIALS PERMIT APPLICATION - GENERAL

The City of Minneapolis Ordinance, Chapter 174.20 requires every building, structure or facility that stores, uses, or handles hazardous materials to have an annual, renewable, hazardous materials permit. The permit will be issued by the Fire Code Official and is to be posted in a conspicuous place on the premises. Your annual permit fee is based on the hazard category assigned to your business, as identified by Fire Inspection Services.

Per MSFC 2701.5.3, a hazardous facility closure plan shall be submitted to the Fire Code Official at least 30 days prior to facility closure.

Hazardous Category Descriptions

Hazardous Material – Any material that poses an unreasonable risk to the health and safety of persons or the environment if it is not properly controlled during handling, storage, manufacturing, process packaging, use, disposal or transportation.

Code 1 – High Hazard / Tier II

Facility, building or commercial entity that files a Tier II chemical inventory form as regulated by Title III of the Superfund Amendments and Reauthorization Act (SARA) of 1986.

Code 2 – Medium Hazard

Commercial building or structure that stores, uses and handles hazardous materials exceeding the maximum allowable quantity as defined by the 2007 Minnesota State Fire Code (2006 IFC with State of Minnesota Amendments). The hazardous materials are used in an open use condition or hazardous process.

Code 3 – Low Hazard

Commercial building or structure that stores, uses and handles hazardous materials in quantities exceeding the permit amount, but not exceeding the maximum allowable quantity as defined by the 2007 Minnesota State Fire Code(2006 IFC with State of Minnesota amendments).
