All positions: Must be at least 18 years old, HS diploma or GED, valid driver's license, and pass pre-employment physical and background check.

Mobile Equipment Operator: Must also have valid MN Class B Commercial Driver's License with air brake and tanker endorsements, one year experience driving trucks of at least 26,001 lbs. GVW, good driving record, pass driving test including towing/backing a trailer, and DOT required physical and drug screen.
