Technical notes:

- [B] Persons of color included all persons who reported that they were of Hispanic or Latino ethnicity or of any single race or combination of races other than White alone.
- [D] The survey question about how well a person speaks English included four levels: “Very well,” “Well,” “Not well,” and “Not at all.”
- [E] Educational attainment was reported for the population ages 25 years and older.
- [F] Household income was reported relative to a past 12-month timeframe and represents 2015 dollars, averaged.
- [G] Cost-burdened housing reflected a past 12-month timeframe. A person’s household was considered “cost-burdened” if housing costs exceeded 30% of their past 12-month household income.
- [I-J] Poverty status was reported relative to a past 12-month timeframe. Poverty status was determined according to thresholds (income cutoffs) by size of family and number of children, developed by the US Census Bureau.
- [K] Persons without health insurance included those who reported that they did not currently have private individual- or employer- based coverage and/or coverage through public programs.
- [L] Workforce unemployment was calculated for the civilian labor force population ages 16 years and over.
