LETTER OF AGREEMENT

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis (hereinafter, "City") and the Minneapolis Professional Employees Association (hereinafter, "Union") are parties to a collective bargaining agreement; and

Whereas, a classification study has resulted in the identification of a new classification, Fleet Services Training Coordinator , that holds a community of interest with other classifications in this union; and

Whereas, the new classification of Fleet Services Training Coordinator has been assigned to Civil Service Grade Level 8 with 393 points in the Equipment Dispatcher/Operations Promotional Line, FLSA status Exempt; and

Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

1. The position of Fleet Services Training Coordinator , grade 8, with 393 points be recognized by the parties as a classification for which the Union is the sole and exclusive certified collective bargaining representative; and
2. The following salary schedule has been negotiated for Fleet Services Training Coordinator , grade 8 with 393 points, effective March 17, 2011:

Effective March 17, 2011* Note this is a 2010-schedule rate. This schedule will increase the next time the MPEA general unit increases occur.

3. This letter represents the full and complete agreement in regards to this matter.


