LETTER OF AGREEMENT Cement Finishers

THIS AGREEMENT, is made and has been entered into effective this 22nd day of March, 2013 by and between the City of Minneapolis (hereinafter the "City"), and the City Employees' Union, Local Union No. 363 a/w Laborers' International Union of North America (hereinafter the "Local 363"), and the Cement Masons, Plasterers and Shophands, Local #633 (hereinafter "Local 633") collectively the "Parties".

WHEREAS, the Local 363 Union has representation rights over Cement Finisher work with the City; and

WHEREAS, there are an insufficient number of City Cement Finishers, and there is a temporary need for additional Cement Finishers in the Public Works Department; and,

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree to temporarily allow the permit hiring of Coment Finishers from the Coment Masons, Plasterers and Shophands, Local #633 through April 30, 2014; and,

AND FURTHER THE PARTIES AGREE

1) The City shall pay the wages as described here.

Effective May 1, 2013: The City shall pay the rack rate as established by the Associated General Contractors Agreement when it is settled in 2013, and retreactively pay temporary employees the established rate upon implementation. In the meantime, The City shall pay the May 1, 2012-established rates as follow:

Rates Effective May 1, 2012:

The City shall pay a package hourly rate of \$48.99 distributed as follows:

1. \$32.39 is the base wage paid to the employee. This is the wage is used for overtime calculations.

 \$16.60 shall be forwarded to the Cement Masons, Plasterers and Shophands, Local No. 633 for distribution into Health & Welfare (\$6.53 per hour), Pension (\$9.12 per hour), HRA (\$.50 per hour), and Training (\$0.45 per hour) funds.

3. An after-tax deduction of \$3.70 per hour worked, including each overtime hour worked, shall be deducted from the employees psycheck and forwarded to the Cement Masons, Plasterers and Shophands, Local No. 633 for deposit into the employee's Minnesota Cement Masons Savings Plan.

- 2) The City shall pay the overtime wager as described here:
 - Time and one-half after 8 hours in one day, or 40 hours in one week, and for all hours worked on Saturdays.
 - Double time for all hours worked on Sundays and on *Recognized Holidays.

*Recognized Holidays mean: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. **When the legal is on a Saturday, Friday will be designated and celebrated as the holiday. When the legal holiday is on Sunday, Monday will be designated and celebrated as the holiday.

3) The City shall pay the Premium wages as described here (2012 rates, may change in 2013. See #1 above): The following hourly premiums shall be paid on a "when performed" basis.

Tunneler (1)

\$0.25 per hour

Foreman (2)

\$2.00 per bour

Swing Scaffold (3)

\$0.25 per hour

1-Paid to all employees when working in an excavated ditch > five (5) feet in depth, underground tunnel, or underground shalt,

2-Paid to all employees who are assigned work as the Foreman.
