LETTER OF AGREEMENT
Senior Information Technology Program Manager

Whereas, the City of Minneapolis (hereinafter, "City") and the Minneapolis Professional Employees Association (hereinafter, "Union") are parties to a collective bargaining agreement; and

Whereas, a new professional classification is established titled Senior Information Technology Program Manager, with 595 points and allocated to grade 13 of the Staff Assistance Promotional Line. The classification is FLSA Exempt.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that:

1. The Senior Information Technology Program Manager , grade 13 and 595 total points, will be recognized by the parties as a classification for which the Union is the sole and exclusive collective bargaining representative; and
2. The following salary schedule for Senior Information Technology Program Manager will be effective August 12, 2013:

3. This letter represents the full and complete agreement in regards to this matter.


